



Account Number

This seven digit number is used identify your account. Please ensure this number is included on any utility payments.

Statement Date

This is the date that the bill was posted to your utility account.

Meter Read From

This date range shows the previous month's read date and the date of the most recent meter reading. The usage reflected on this invoice was used within this date range.

This is the last date that your invoice can be paid without being considered late. Bills are due upon receipt as they are for services rendered over the previous month. This section will also specify if there are any past due amounts that need to be paid immediately to ensure continued services.

Message Section

This section can include special messages such as important city updates, rate increases, billing options, etc.

Balance Forward

This will reflect any previous balance remaining on the account if unpaid.

This is the amount of your last payment made to the account.

8 Penalty

Γhis specifies the amount of any potential penalty charges assessed to the account if a balance is late.

Meter Usage Chart

This chart shows how Utility Customer Service calculates the amount of water used for this billing period. It takes your current reading, subtracts your previous month's reading, and uses a fixed multiplier to convert your usage into gallons. The city measures your water in centum cubic feet (CCF) at the meter and converts this into gallons to show your billed consumption. Your usage in CCF is multiplied by a conversion factor of 0.748. In this example, the current reading was 583 and the previous reading was 578, indicating an increase of 5 CCF. This amount is multiplied by 0.748 to get a billed consumption of 3.7. The usage on this bill is 3.7 or 3,700 gallons.

Usage, Service, Charge

This section provides a break down of the usage and individual charges. In this example you can see the usage is 3.7. The charge for "Domestic Water Inside City <1"" is \$33.12. You will also see charges for sewer/ wastewater, solid waste/recycling service, and stormwater. Each of these services have their own individual charges displayed here.

10% Utility Tax.

This is the utility tax that is charged for your water service. In this case, the charge is \$3.31. This tax goes to city funds for utility projects.

Total Taxes and Francise Fees

This is the amount of your total taxes and fees that are charged.

Current Bill Due

This is the current amount due for this month's service only.

This is the total amount due, including any previous unpaid charges.
